NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT (Chronological log, if applicable, to be attached)

Turning Point USA Mountain West Regional Conference took place in Denver at the Grand Hyatt Hotel, 1750 Welton Street, on Saturday, March 18, 2017 and concludes Sunday, March 19, 2017. The conference included guest speakers, students and activities planned around the conservative movement. Protest/demonstration activity developed at the entrance to the A separate demonstration occurred at Civic hotel Center Park that resulted in a march down the 16th Street Mall. the march, which remained peaceful throughout. At 1730 hours, members of the Turning Point conference formed a counter protest and assembled outside of the hotel, which eventually led to a disturbance between the two groups and the subsequent arrest of two additional parties.

INFORMATION ITEM: On 3-18-17, at 0555, Dist. 6 officers responded to the Grand Hyatt Hotel on report of criminal mischief in progress and subsequently arrested 2 parties who were observed defacing the building with spray paint and stencil, "Make Racists Afraid Again" - 651C arrested
