NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT (Chronological log, if applicable, to be attached)

Turning Point USA Mountain West Regional Conference took place in Denver at the Grand Hyatt Hotel, 1750 Welton Street, on Saturday, March 18, 2017 and concludes Sunday, March 19, 2017. The conference included guest speakers, students and activities planned around the conservative movement. Protest/demonstration activity developed at the entrance to the hotel [REDACTED]. A separate demonstration occurred at Civic Center Park that resulted in a march down the 16th Street Mall. [REDACTED] the march, which remained peaceful throughout. At 1730 hours, members of the Turning Point conference formed a counter protest and assembled outside of the hotel, which eventually led to a disturbance between the two groups and the subsequent arrest of two additional parties.

INFORMATION ITEM: On 3-18-17, at 0555, Dist. 6 officers responded to the Grand Hyatt Hotel on report of criminal mischief in progress and subsequently arrested 2 parties who were observed defacing the building with spray paint and stencil, "Make Racists Afraid Again" – **651C arrested** [REDACTED]

0855 hours	Another group of 10 anarchists, dressed in black, observed in the 1800 block of Welton
0900 hours	Groups converge on the north east corner of the Grand Hyatt Hotel, 1750 Welton, valet entrance
0904 hours	Command 6 speaks to the group, advised on blocking the sidewalk and staying out of the driveway
0910 hours	Anarchist group increases to 40 participants, dressed in black clothing, faces covered

1100 hours	Size of group decreases to 30 participants
1115 hours	Group departs the area; 10 heading toward 16 th St. Mall, remaining group towards 20 th and Broadway
1125 hours	Group is observed placing banners and signs into a gold colored Honda Accord, [REDACTED], 1600 block of Welton
1130 hours	Approximately 20 individuals arrive at Civic Center Park Amphitheater for "Demand Russia-Trump Ties Investigation" rally
1200 hours	Civic Center group increases to 50 people
1210 hours	Group of 20 citizens hold a prayer vigil inside Civic Center Park, adjacent to the rally
1238 hours	Civic Center group begins marching toward 16 th Street Mall, prayer group stays behind
1245 hours	Group staying on the sidewalk, enters 16 th St. Mall from Cleveland Pl.
1255 hours	Staying on the sidewalk, no problems, [REDACTED]
1257 hours	[REDACTED] report a fire alarm pulled at the hotel, 1750 Welton Street; suspect [REDACTED] [REDACTED] arrested on site by [REDACTED]; jailed for trespass/false reporting of a fire alarm, [REDACTED]
1310 hours	March continues on the Mall; group turns at Market Street and heads back toward Civic Center
1335 hours	Group marching makes it's way back to Civic Center Park Amphitheater, 80 people present
1340 hours	Civic Center Park prayer group disbands and begins to leave the area

1730 hours	20 Turning Point conference members create a counter protest and assemble at the hotel valet entrance; holding signs and chanting; [REDACTED]
1745 hours	Turning Point counter protest group retreats back inside the hotel
1755 hours	Medical call at the hotel; EMS and DFD responding; unrelated to protest/conference activity
1803 hours	Turning Point counter protest group returns outside; anarchist group approaches; disturbance ensues; two arrests made by [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] jailed for Distraction of Private Property and Disturbing the Peace. [REDACTED] jailed for Interference with the Police; [REDACTED]
1830 hours	Two protest groups remain; counter protest group increases to 35 people
1840 hours	Turning Point counter protest group retreats and enters the hotel
1900 hours	Remaining protest group begins to leave the area
