NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT (Chronological log, if applicable, to be attached)

On 4-28-2015 members of the Denver Police Department were assigned to the area of Auraria Campus and Colfax & Broadway to monitor possible protest activity. There was a planned panel event at the Tivoli Student Union from 1730 – 1930 hours. Occupy Denver promoted the same event in an attempt to force an anti-law enforcement agenda.

Available response personnel consisted primarily of [REDACTED]. This complement was augmented by [REDACTED].

By 1730 hours seven protestors gathered on the northwest corner of Colfax & Broadway. The group grew to around 12 by 1800 hours, and demonstrated peacefully by holding banners and signs. Approximately 70 people attended the Auraria Tivoli event, which was also peaceful. At approximately 1930 hours, a group of around 30 protestors gathered at Colfax & Speer Blvd. The group at Colfax & Broadway appeared to have grown to around 20 people. At 1940 hours, [REDACTED] resources and [REDACTED] bus were deployed to W. Colfax Avenue at Eliot Street to prevent protestors from attempting to gain access to the I-25 highway. Construction crews on westbound Colfax Avenue west of I-25 were notified of possible protest activity.

At 2015 hours, the group of 45 now at Colfax and Speer began to march, walking eastbound on Colfax on the north side in the crosswalk. The group initially marched on the sidewalk, obeying traffic laws. Shortly thereafter, the group began to walk in the street, blocking westbound traffic on Colfax at Glenarm Place. At 2024 hours, Commander Lopez gave amplified orders for the group to get back on the sidewalk. The group complied for a couple blocks. Some members walked in the street again between Tremont and Cleveland. They joined the Colfax and Broadway group at around 2035 hours.

The group of about 75 walked eastbound across Broadway, southbound into Colfax Avenue, then back northbound. They crossed Broadway to the west and walked north toward the 16th Street Mall at 2040 hours. Many group members marched in the street on the Mall and rallied at Court. RTD was notified. The [REDACTED] bus and [REDACTED] resources were relocated to Union Station. The group began marching again, taking both lanes and disrupting the RTD Shuttle service.

The group crossed Curtis at 2055 hours and arrived at Union Station via Wynkoop at 2110 hours. The group rallied there while Union Station was protected by the DPD complement. At 2130 hours, some of the group appeared to dissipate. About 30 of the group members rallied at 16th and Wynkoop. At 2140 hours that group began to disperse. Another splinter group was observed walking on the sidewalk near the fire station at Colfax & Speer.

There were no arrests or reports of injuries or use of force. All resources were released and the [REDACTED] channel closed by 2200 hours.
